Application Information

Scholarships cover the full cost of tuition and transportation from the main campus each day, if required. Scholarship applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until all scholarships are granted.

All applicants must submit a letter of recommendation from a teacher or other adult, non-family member who has known the applicant for at least two years. Applicants must also submit a 250-word statement if why he/she is interested in participating in COSA.

Applicants must have met the criteria for eligibility in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) within the past 12 months. Parents must provide either a letter of eligibility from the child's school district, or else a statement of current income and household size. If the latter is provided, eligibility will be based on the same federal standards used by the NSLP, the most recent of which can be found at <http://www.fns.usda.gov/cnd/Governance/notices/iegs/IEGs.htm>. Preference will be given to students residing in Boston, Chelsea, Revere, Malden, Everett, Lynn, and Salem.
